## CALL TO ORDER /ADMINISTRATIVE TASKS/UPDATES:

1. Call to Order: Chairman Ed Riggs called the meeting to order.

**2. Minutes:** Spencer Wetmore asked that a correction be made to the May 13, 2019 minutes to finish a sentence under number three, which previously read "TERC welcomed Kenneth May, who is the SC Arts Commission recommendation for..." After sentence correction, Ms. Wetmore made a motion to approve the minutes. This was seconded by Dan Blumenstock and approved by the full committee.
